## GROUND RULES FOR A CONSTRUCTIVE DISCUSSION

- 1. Listen to the others, do not interrupt or start additional discussions.
- 2. Relate what you say to what the others have said and use everyday language.
- 3. Tell about your own experience.
- 4. Talk to the others directly and ask about their views.
- 5. **Be present** and respect the others and the confidentiality of the discussion
- 6. Find and bring together. Boldly deal with emerging conflicts and find issues that have gone unnoticed.

The National Dialogue model is not a political process and it does not aim for unanimity or decision-making. The aim is to gain as extensive an understanding as possible of people's experiences and the economic, social and ecological challenges at hand.
